**March 2026 Communication**

NEW MEETING DATE. Sunday, May 17, 2026, at 10:00 am, the YACSD board of directors will meet in the Tenaya Lodge. This is an open, public meeting you are welcome to attend. ZOOM is no longer available. Topics of discussion will be snow removal for next year, budget adoption for 2026-27 and 2027-28, FIREWISE acceptance and our responsibility to keep it going.

FIREWISE. Congratulations and thanks go to the group of folks who worked long and hard for Fish Camp to be accepted into the FIREWISE program. Fish Camp Fire Rescue sent out an email with the certificate to give to your insurance carrier to get a discount on your premiums. PLEASE keep track of the hours you spend to clean up your property after this winter's damages and debris. PLEASE keep track of how much you spend to have others clean-up your property. FIREWISE collects this information to show that the community is working to help itself. For example, the Glendennings keep track of the hours spent on a calendar to keep the info easily accessible.

VEGETATION REDUCTION/CLEAN-UP. Winter was delayed and short but it was mighty. There are many branches and trees that came down this winter. The snow is quickly receding and the debris will be more visible and drying out. Currently, you do not need a burn permit to do residential burning. Later this spring you may need to get a burn permit. You may go to [www.burnpermit.fire.ca.gov](http://www.burnpermit.fire.ca.gov) to fill out and print your own permit. The State Fire Marshall may cut off residential vegetation burning PRIOR to May 1, especially with this heat wave California is currently experiencing. You need to call **1.888.440.2876** to find out if each day is "a permissive burn day in Mariposa County" whether a permit is required or not.

VACANCY ON YACSD BOARD OF DIRECTORS. Yes, there are 2 opportunities for your involvement with YACSD. Our board usually meets quarterly for less than 2 hours, so the time commitment is not overwhelming. You need to be a registered voter within the boundaries of YACSD and have an interest in improving YACSD and the Fish Camp area.

FCPAC (FISH CAMP PLANNING ADVISORY COUNCIL) MEETING. Sat., April 25, 2026, at 9:30 am, is the next and possibly last Fish Camp Planning Advisory Council meeting at the Tenaya Lodge. The county has been trying to dissolve many of the advisory councils for the last couple of years. This group covers all of Fish Camp and presents info from Mariposa County.
