## YACSD BYLAWS SECTION 7.11 AMENDMENT

## Board of Directors of the Yosemite Alpine Community Services District Fish Camp, CA

## Approved July 15, 2023

For purposes of context. Section 7.10 of the YACSD Bylaws reads:

<u>Payment of Bills Owed to the District.</u> Billing statements shall be made to all property owners annually, as soon as possible after July 1st and before July 31<sup>st</sup>. Bills for water services, fees, and taxes shall be due and payable immediately upon mailing. Bills shall become delinquent when payment is not received by September 1<sup>st</sup> or later date as may be specific in the billing statement.

## The amended bylaw **Section 7.11** reads:

Late Payment Penalties. If all or part of a bill is not paid, the District may discontinue any or all services pursuant to Government Code section 61115(a)(3)(B). For instance, water service may be discontinued when a delinquency in any payment occurs, until payment is made in full or a payment schedule is agreed between the Treasurer and the property owner. Penalties may be imposed when payment is delinquent. The basic penalty for the nonpayment of charges shall not exceed 10 percent, plus an additional penalty of not more than one percent per month for the nonpayment of the charges and the basic penalty.

If payment is not received as described above, the Treasurer will issue a 10 Day Water Turn-off Notice to the property owner. If payment is not received by the turn-off date, the Treasurer will notify the Water Master (or designate) to turn off the water service to the property. A turn-off fee of \$100.00 will be added to the outstanding bill. In order to restore service, full payment of the original billing, the shut-off fee, penalties and a \$100.00 turn-on fee must be paid by certified check.

In some circumstances such as unforeseen financial hardship, the Treasurer may agree to a payment plan for an outstanding bill. If water service has already been turned off, a payment plan will not be offered and full payment must be made as described above. If water service has not been turned off, the Treasurer may enter into a payment arrangement of not less than \$300.00 per month until the original bill and additional penalties have been paid. An additional penalty of one percent per month will continue accruing on the unpaid balance. Missing a payment will result in the immediate issuance of a 10 day water turn-off notice and subsequent actions as described above.

There are some cases where property owners develop an undetected leak in their water line(s). To minimize this situation, the YACSD makes ongoing reminders to property owners to turn off their water mains when their properties are unoccupied. In the case of an undetected leak, the property owner may request a 25% discount of the water charge portion of the bill. The property owner must make this request in writing within 10 days of the leak being detected and must document the pre-emptive actions the owner took to prevent such an occurrence. Failing to shut off the water main will not be an adequate justification for a reduction of the bill. Because this is a "judgment call" the Chairperson of the Board will make the decision as to whether the water charge portion may be discounted.
