METER READING. Thank you to all who cleared the area around and inside their water meters. The meter reading crew was able to read the meters with very little removal of the dirt left by the ground squirrels and lizards. The crew took into consideration the restriction of travel on our property owners when clearing the meters of debris. It is hoped that next year the boxes and areas will be cleaner.

VEGETATION REMOVAL. Thank you to all who have removed the downed and dead vegetation from this past winter. Some folks were able to participate in the chipping program sponsored by the Mariposa County Fire Safe Council. There may be a chipping program in the fall. Donn Harter will be checking on that shortly. Please contact him if you are interested. **PLEASE** be conscious of potential erosion and water run-off when you are clearing your property of plant material. Having dirt/mud and excessive water run-off does not make for a good neighbor and makes more work for your YACSD.

YACSD BOARD MEETING JUNE 27, 2020. Chair Karen Green led a successful meeting via ZOOM with several property owners and all Board members in attendance. Water Master Tim McGinty reported that he will be building wood cases around the valves at the water tanks. He will be replacing the water meter on Well #1East. Well #2West will be getting repaired this summer.

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROTESTS OF PROPOSED WATER SERVICE FEES. As per Prop 218, YACSD held a Public Hearing of the property owners regarding the proposed Water Service Fees during the board meeting on June 27 for the upcoming fiscal years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. YACSD received 2 Protest Letters via mail and none via email. Chair Green read the 2 letters aloud during the meeting. Since a majority of property owners did not submit written protests to the Water Service Fee, the proposed budget was adopted by the Board.
